Items NEVER Accepted

- Red clothing, household items, children's clothing
- Formal clothing or dress clothing, high heels, lingerie, jewelry
- Shoes (or socks) without a mate in in disrepair
- Damaged or heavily stained clothing
- Alcohol based-products (i.e., hand sanitizer mouthwash)





Urgent Items ALWAYS Accepted

- Mittens, toques, gloves, scarves, jackets, walking shoes & boots
- T-shirts, sweaters, hoodies, sweatpants, jeans, leggings
- Sleeping bags, tents, blankets, camping mats
- Deodorant, hairbrushes & combs, menstrual supplies
- Body wash, shampoo & conditioner, hand & body lotion, toothbrushes & toothpaste

The Donation room is an emergency donation room. It means that staff stock items that help Boyle Street Community Services meet the urgent and immediate needs of our community. Donations need to be clean, new, or gently used.
